Auction Highlights

Held on June 10th 2005 in Sydney the much anticipated Inaugural Kurt Jaggard Monetary Auction was an outstanding success realising in excess of \$3 million from just 1080 lots available setting many new world auction price records in the process including: (NB: All prices listed are the knock-down price and exclude the 16.5% buyers premium).

The strongest sessions were undoubtedly the Pre-1955 Pattern & Proof issues, Australian Rarities, Australian Copper, Australian Half Sovereigns and the Australian Banknote section.

The Australian Banknote section was very strong with the highlight being the fresh selection of R.11 & R.12 10 Shilling notes mostly in aUNC condition with approximately 50 notes fetching over \$230,000 some \$100,000 over pre sale estimates!! Other strong results include \$28,000 for the Mint bundle of One Pound R.34, \$9,500 for an Uncirculated pair of AA00 (R.49) 5 Pounds and \$15,000 for a pair of (R.72S) \$1 Stars to name a few!!

Both Australian gold Proof Sovereigns were sold one at \$50,000 and the other \$54,000 and all Commonwealth Silver & Copper pre 1955 Proofs sold for a combined total of approximately \$230,000 for just 14 lots which compared with presale estimates of just \$160,000!!.

All four 1813 NSW Dumps sold for prices between \$8,000 and \$23,000 and all three 1813 NSW Holey Dollars sold at around estimate with the best two fetching \$45,000 and \$80,000 respectively.

All four Square Kookaburra Pennies sold at or just over estimate (for \$37,500 up to \$52,500 each), both type 1 1852 Adelaide Pounds sold at estimate (\$50,000 and \$65,000) and three 1930 Pennies sold between \$20,000 and \$23,000 each.
