555. **Republic Denarius**, M. Plaetorius M.F. Cestianus, 69BC. Obv: Bon Eventus. Rev: Caduceus. (Similar S#342). Scarce. VF \$250-325
556. **Republic Denarius**, T. Carisius, 46BC. Obv: Head of Aphrodisian Sibyl. Rev: Sphinx. (Similar sear#3214). VF \$225-275
