



- 569.** 1916 Mule Halfpenny, George V. *Extremely Rare with an estimated 10 only known and this one a nice, otherwise problem free chocolate example that would rate as the third or 4th finest known.* Fine. \$45,000-65,000



- 576.** 1930 Penny, George V. *A most attractive high grade Penny with full centre diamond, nice high clear rims, nice chocolate colour & totally problem free.* Strict VF \$38,000-40,000



- 570.** 1919 Type 3 Square Kookaburra Penny. *Very Rare.* FDC. \$45,000-50,000



- 577.** 1930 Penny, George V. *A Premium example with absolutely full sharp centre diamond, seldom ever available in this grade and Very Rare and highly desirable as such.* gVF \$60,000
